

Does the solar cycle influence the Asian summer monsoon?

The result supports reconstructed terrestrial records and underlines considerable influences of the solar cycle on the variation of the Asian Summer Monsoon.

How did asynchronous solar forcing influence ecosystem change in Northeast China?

Holocene vegetation optimum was asynchronous between the different regions of NE China. Solar forcing and ENSO regulated the change rate of ecosystems in Northeast China. Understanding long-term (centennial- to millennial-scale) ecosystem transformation and dynamics is a key factor in the prediction of ecosystems under ongoing climate change.

Does solar activity influence monsoon precipitation over South and East Asia?

In addition, paleo-records indicate the correlation between the long-term solar cycle and the variation of the Asian Monsoon. This study attempts to clarify the role of solar activity in monsoonal precipitation over South and East Asia.

Does solar activity drive vegetation ROC in Northeast China?

The ~1500-yr quasi-periodicity is consistent with the ~1500-yr climatic cycle proposed by Bond et al. (1997), generally considered to be driven by solar activity; it's speculated that solar activity has been a significant driver of vegetation ROC in Northeast China on the millennial timescale.

Why is the Asian monsoon important?

Furthermore, a physical explanation is provided for the solar signals in the Asian Monsoon in paleo-evidences. As a dominant climate system in East and South Asia, the Asian Monsoon (AM) has considerable impacts on local agriculture, economy, and lives, revealing the significance of its future prediction.

What is the climate like in East Asia?
